On November 29, 1963, the Latent Fingerprint Section of the Identification Division advised as follows concerning specimens received by personal delivery by SA VINCENT E. DRAIN and SA WARREN DE BRUEYS on November 23, 1963:

> Specimens: Numerous miscellaneous items of personal effects of Lee Harvey Oswald Enco map of Dallas and Fort Worth, Q47 One cartridge case, Q48

One piece of cardboard bearing latent palm print Four cardboard boxes Resubmission of Q6 through Q13

Numerous latent impressions. of value were developed on the currently submitted specimens.

Comparisons were made and three latent palm prints and two latent fingerprints developed on the Enco map of the Fort Worth - Dallas area were identified as the finger and palm prints of Lee Harvey Oswald, FBI #327925D.

One latent palm print on a piece of cardboard, your item #1, taken from a carton from the room in which the shots were fired was identified as the right palm print of Oswald.

One latent fingerprint and one latent palm print developed on the cardboard box marked "A" from the same room have been identified as the fingerprint and palm print of Oswald.

In addition, eight latent fingerprints and two latent palm prints developed on the personal effects of Oswald were identified as his fingerprints and palm prints.

No latent impressions were identified as the fingerprints of Jack Leon Ruby, FBI #693083E. Additional comparisons of the unidentified latent impressions will be made upon the receipt of the major case prints of Ruby.
