Dear Mark,

Last night I heard a tape of the interview of Jim Garrison by you and Mort Sahl on April 3rd, in which several references are made to the suppression of page 47 of Oswald's address book (notebook), presumably Commission Exhibit No. 18.

If you will look in Volume XVI, page 54 of the volume, you will find page 47 reproduced in full, both in a photocopy of the actual page of the notebook and in a printed translation. I took a quick look through the notebook in its entirety (CE 18) and it seems to contain photocopies of every page, although only the pages or parts of pages in the Russian language are repeated in print in English. On the basis of a hasty scanning, it is my impression that no pages of the address book have been suppressed.
