For the first time John Kennedy's assassination is being investigated inside and under the rules of the American judicial system. THIS is the difference between Garrison and Earl Warren - and it is a big difference.

In America the Judge sets the trial date. Mr. Garrison has not procrastinated. The delays have been caused by demands of the defense for more time. The delay is small compared to the importance of getting a trial by jury and cross examination of witnesses.

Arnoni, wait. There will be plenty of time for you to join the throngs in shouting for joy if Garrison falls flat on his face. If he makes no case, I had rather hoped you would join me in a dark corner for a heartbreaking cry.
