In response to your suggestion that William Gurvich was the "Chief Investigator" for this office, I decided to look through the files to examine the memoranda he filed in the case. These memoranda, all designated "TO: JIM GARRISON, District Attorney," were designated "FROM. . . as follows:

Thus, Gurvich's memoranda do seem to reflect some uncertainty in his mind as to his function in the office, but do not indicate that he ever thought of himself as Chief Investigator. I have found no memorandum which he signs 'Chief Investigator', nor one which he signs in any fashion other than those listed above.

I also note that I have been unable to find a memo by Gurvich dated later than April 24, although he did not talk to Robert Kennedy until 2 months later.
