

Re: Extradition of 5/27/68  
Edgar & Bradley

Richard Sprague and  
Trent Jugh continue to  
believe that one of 3  
"tramps" in photo taken at  
Beuley Plaza is Bradley.  
Garrison and others in his  
office at one time agreed  
the "tramp" was Bradley.

Then, Roger Craig "Remember"  
his conversation with a  
Secret Service agent near  
TSDB entrance and  
"recalled" that the agent  
was in fact Bradley.  
Shortly thereafter in a  
photo of the TSDB exterior

Craig was located in  
conversation with a well-  
dressed man, then also  
identified as Bradley.

Garrison at this time  
no longer claims that  
the "tramp" is

Bradley and is worried  
that his earlier position —  
if it becomes known —  
will lead to a refusal by  
California to extradite.

When Bradley was  
first named by Garrison,  
it was on the sole  
basis of (1) an  
anonymous letter, and  
(2) the photo of the  
"tramp," then identified  
as Bradley.

It was then said by a  
reliable source that  
Garrison was in fact  
fearful that extradition  
would be granted,  
since he had no real  
evidence against  
Bradley. Now, of  
course, he has Roger  
Craig and the  
photograph of the  
"agent."
