

Correction

Upon rechecking the transcript of Roger Craig's testimony, I find that Craig was offered the opportunity to "follow or to waive signing of the deposition" and was asked "do you want to sign it?" (6H 271). Craig replied: "It makes no difference to me."

While Garrison's statement at the American University ("...and he actually said 'yes' but they put in the printed copy 'no'...") is not a faithful account of the printed transcript, he is correct in stating that Craig was offered an opportunity to sign the transcript.

Because the question and answer did not appear at the end of the deposition, as was the usual practice, but in the body of the testimony, this passage of the transcript was overlooked in the first instance. I am glad to correct this error, which I regret.
