Reference is made to your current application for correction of military records to show that you were retired effective 29 October 1959 by reason of disability.


The regulation which governs the operation of this Board provides that it may deny an application without a formal hearing in the absence of evidence of probable material error or injustice.

A review of the records of this office reveals that your case was carefully considered on the basis of your previous application. As a result, the Board determined on 10 July 1963 that there was no material evidence of error or injustice in connection with your failure to be separated from the Army in October 1959 by reason of disability which would warrant a hearing. Accordingly, your application was denied, and you were so informed by The Adjutant General under date of 26 July 1963.

Your current application and the new evidence submitted by your counsel, the testimony of Edwin A. Weinstein, M.D., have been carefully examined in conjunction with the evidence which was of record in your case. This study has resulted in the determination that no basis has been furnished which would justify a decision other than that made by the Board on 10 July 1963. Under these circumstances, the Board contemplates no further action in the matter.

Your counsel has been furnished a copy of this letter.

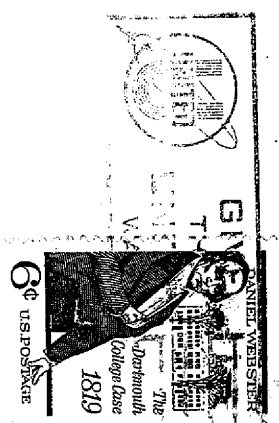
