"...When President JFK was shot I was standing at the corner of Record and Elm Streets after having watched the parade on Main Street. I was accompanied by Edward Shields...and a man I know only as 'James' who was employed at the Classified Parking Lot on the corner of Record and Elm Streets...I did not see LHO when the President was shot...After the President was shot I returned to the...Depository Building, and was told by a Dallas policeman that I could not enter the building. About an hour later I went to the Dallas Police Department was was questioned by the police for about 45 minutes. Then I returned to the...Depository Building about 5 o'clock that same afternoon to pick up my hat and coat. I left the building a few minutes after I picked up my hat and coat..."
