Dear Sylvia:

Enclosed is the newsletter you asked to borrow, plus the sheet on clippings promised earlier. We hope it helps the researchers.

Since I'm putting it in letters to some other researchers, let me briefly outline our fall plans for you. As this November will be the fifth anniversary of the assassination, and since the Ray (?) and Sirhan trials are scheduled to begin then, we want to use the public awareness of assassinations to impress more Americans with the true facts. Therefore, to use the media to our best advantage at an important time, we are planning on a four day period of intensive activity. Beginning November 21 we will have our volunteers petitioning, leafleting, pasting, etc., and we will organize radio and television talk and panel shows for researchers in town at that time (to which end we are currently extending invitations). The will, if possible, release new evidence during this period as well. The evening of the 22nd will be devoted to a big program in an uptown theatre, with many researchers present, and, if we can arrange it, television coverage. We will do as much as finances and manpower allow. The final day, the 24, will be set aside for a private conference of researchers, to discuss the cases, and what the future might hold in store.

We hope you will be able to join us at that time for many of our activities. You will be hearing more from me as time progresses.
