You are invited to a post-HSCA conclave on November 9, 10 and 11 at our summer place in Deep Creek Lake, Maryland, in the mountains about 200 miles west of Washington.

The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss in depth 1) the findings of the HSCA on the JFK case; 2) "where we are" on various aspects of the investigation; and 3) where we should be going and how do we get there.

There will be a detailed agenda and a moderator will be named for each session in an attempt to supply a modicum of decorum to the meetings. We will not adhere to Roberts Rules, but participants will get more out of the meetings if we operate under some self-discipline.
