Dear Mr. Treleaven,

Thank you for your letter of September 15, 1965, which I read with pleasure.

The subject index is typed on white letter-size paper (8-1/2 x 11") and consists of 91 loose sheets in a manila folder. The master copy is probably suitable for photo-offset process and loose-leaf or spiral binding, as the left-hand margins are generally uniform. In addition to the master copy, I have one thermofax copy from which I am detaching about fifteen sample pages for your inspection.

As you will see, there is some variation in the density of material according to page, so that the total of 91 pages gives an approximate rather than an exact indication of the size of the index.

I should perhaps say that I am not a professional indexer and that I undertook the preparation of this subject index on a pragmatic basis, finding myself unable to proceed without such an instrument on a comparative study which I am writing. Several other researchers who are working with the Hearings and Exhibits urged me to concentrate on the index, which they offered to purchase before the first page was even typed. This leads me to believe that the index will have high, value despite its specialized character.
