Under date of November 29, 1963, the FBI Laboratory advised as follows:

Specimens received personally on November 27, 1963.

Q50 Small notebook containing Russian writing  
(Item #350)

Q51 Seventeen pages of handwriting on Holland  
American Line stationery (Items #123, #124,  
and #125)

Result of examination:

It was concluded that the seventeen pages of handwriting, Q51, were written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case.

Most of the writing contained in Q50 is in Russian script and is not comparable with the known writings of OSWALD in English. Therefore, no conclusion could be reached whether OSWALD wrote any of the Russian script writing in Q50. However, it was concluded that OSWALD, K4 and K5, did not write the writing in English in Q50 in the wording "Mrs. Anna Neller Meller 5930 $\frac{1}{2}$  La Vista Dr. Dallas 6, Texas TA 3-22-19."
