Result of examination:

It was concluded that the questioned handwriting in Q439, which is on a blank sheet which faces the inside back

cover, was written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case. The remaining brief notations in Q439 are too limited for an adequate handwriting examination.

The various isolated words appearing in Q440 are too limited for an adequate comparison with the known writings of OSWALD, K4 and K5. However, some handwriting and hand printing similarities were noted common to the questioned writings in Q440 and the known writings of OSWALD.

No indented writings of significance were noted in Q439 and Q440.
