
Superior Court of the State of California for the County of Los Angeles, No. A 233421, order re publicity.

People of the State of California. Plaintiffs vs. Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, Defendant.

The Grand Jury having returned an indictment in this matter on this date, June 7, 1968, this Court now has jurisdiction over all proceedings in this case for the first time. Therefore, the Court is now in a legal position to make certain orders respecting this matter.

Under our Constitution, each defendant is entitled to the due process of the law and a fair trial. The Court has an affirmative duty to do everything possible within its Constitutional powers and jurisdiction to make certain that each defendant does receive a fair trial.

In order to fulfill that Constitutional duty to guarantee that the defendant does receive a fair trial, and because of the obvious public interest in this matter which has produced massive news media publicity, and it further appearing to the Court that the dissemination by any means of public communication of any




## "BLACKOUT" ON SIRHAN MAY PROTECT FUTURE ASSASSINS

The Supreme Court of the United States and many lower courts in the land appear committed to issuing decisions which not only go against the spirit and the letter of the American Constitution, but which also serve to coddle and protect criminals at the expense of an increasingly victimized society. Nothing better illustrates this point than the utter disregard for the Constitutional guarantees of freedom of speech shown by the Superior Court of California for the County of Los Angeles. This court has issued an order establishing an almost total blackout of news and information regarding pertinent facts in the case of Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, Robert Kennedy's "alleged" assassin. As a public service, we herein reprint the order.

out-of-court statements relating to this case may interfere with the Constitutional right of the defendant to a fair trial and disrupt the proper administration of justice, the Court, on its own motion, will now issue the following orders, a violation of which will result in swift

action to punish for contempt any offender within the jurisdiction of this Court.

It is the order of this Court that no party to this action nor any attorney connected with this case as defense counsel or as prosecutor, nor any other attorney, nor any judicial officer or employee, nor any public official, including but not limited to any chief of police, nor any sheriff, nor any agent, deputy, or employee of any such persons, nor any grand juror, nor any witness having appeared before the Grand Jury in this matter, nor any person subpoenaed to testify at the trial of this matter, shall release or authorize the release for public dissemination of any purported extrajudicial statement of the defendant relating to this case, nor shall any such persons release or authorize the release of any documents, exhibits or any evidence, the admissibility of which may have to be determined by the Court, nor shall any such person



make any statement for public dissemination as to the existence or possible existence of any documents, exhibits, or any other evidence, the admissibility of which may have to be determined by the Court. Nor shall any such persons express outside of court an opinion or make any comment for public dissemination as to the weight, value, or effect. of any evidence as tending to establish guilt or innocence. Nor shall any such persons make any statement outside of court as to the nature, substance, or effect of any testimony that has been given. Nor shall any such persons issue any statement as to the identity of any prospective witness, or his probable testimony, or the effect thereof. Nor shall any person make any out-of-court statement as to the nature, source, or effect of any purported evidence alleged to have been accumulated as a result of the investigation of this matter. Nor shall any such person or any witness, whether or not under subpoena, make any statement as to the content. nature, substance or effect of any testimony which may be given in any proceeding related to this matter, except that a witness may discuss any matter with any attorney of record or agent thereof.

This order does not include any of the following: 1) Factual statements of the accused person's name, age, residence, occupation and family status: 2) The circumstances of the arrest, namely, the time and place of the arrest, the identity of the arresting and investigating officers and agencies, and the length of the investigation, 3) The nature, substance, and text of the charge including a brief description of the offenses charged; 4) Quotations from, or any reference without comment to, public records of the Court in the case,

or to other records of communications heretofore disseminated to the public. 5) The scheduling and result of any stage of the judicial proceeding held in open court in an open or public session. 6) A request for assistance in obtaining evidence. 7) Any information as to any person not in custody who is sought as a possible suspect or witness, nor any statement aimed at warning the public of any possible danger as to such person not in custody. 8) A request for assistance in the obtaining of evidence or the names of possible witnesses.

Further, this order is not intended to preclude any witness from discussing any matter in connection with any of the attorneys representing the defendant or the People, or any representative of such attorneys.

It is further ordered that a copy of this order be attached to any subpoena served on any witness in this matter, and that the return of service of the subpoena shall also include the fact of service of a copy of this order. This order shall be in force until this matter shall be disposed of or until further order of the Court. Dated June 7, 1968. (Signed) Arthur L. Alarcon, Judge of the Supreme Court. (End order)

The immediate results of Judge Alarcon's draconian measures have been that a complete mantle of protective silence has been cast upon the Sishan

case.

Naturally, persons who might otherwise come forth with pertinent information on the alleged slayer's conduct and motives for assassinating Senator Kennedy are no doubt afraid to open their respective mouths lest they bring upon themselves the Court's wrath.

One wonders if Sirhan's "rights" would have been so carefully guarded had he not been, as he undoubtedly is, a Castroite fanatic and a militant "New Leftist." To claim that the perpetrator of an assassination witnessed by millions of persons cannot obtain a "fair trial" because he has been "pre-judged" is a judicial absurdity acceptable only where large segments of the citizenry can no longer tell right from wrong due to long years of mental conditioning to the pernicious vagaries of fake liberalism.

About the most one can expect from Judge Alarcon's order is that it may encourage other potential assassins to seek out their victims, knowing beforehand that every imaginable effort will be made to guard them against rightful exposure and public condemnation.

Criminals may also reach the dangerous conclusion that by committing a public assassination, they will be immune to punishment on the basis of having been "pre-judged." This is what the attorney for Martin Luther King's alleged killer is now sustaining!
