Result of examination:

It was concluded that Qc102 is a fraudulent and counterfeit card. It was prepared from OSWALD's original Notice of Classification in his name and contained in his wallet. From OSWALD's original Notice of Classification wallet three negatives were prepared. These three negatives are part of item 225 previously submitted by your office. These three negatives were used in preparing the face of Qc102.

The reverse side of Qc102 was not prepared from OSWALD's original Notice of Classification or from his original Registration Certificate both of which were in his wallet nor does the data on the reverse side of Qc102 his wallet nor does the data on the back of OSWALD's conform to the descriptive data on the back of OSWALD's criginal Registration Certificate. It is noted that the criginal Registration Certificates and is not the reverse sides of Registration Certificates and is not the reverse side of his Notice of Classification card. Hence, it is apparent that at one time OSWALD had at least one other criginal Registration Certificate available.

The handwritten signature of Hidell on Qc102 is not sufficiently comparable with the available known writings of LEE HARVEY OSWALD to determine whether he did or did not prepare the Hidell signature.
