REBUTEL SIX FIFTYTWO P. M., TODAY, AND NEW ORLEANS TEL ELEVEN ZERO FOUR A. M., TODAY.

ATTORNEY G. WRAY WILL NOT AVAILABLE AT NEW ORLEANS TONIGHT. WILL BE INTERVIEWED NOVEMBER TWENTYSEVEN NEXT.

FOR INFORMATION BUREAU, DAVID WILLIAM FERRIE ON INTERVIEW NOVEMBER TWENTYFIVE, SIXTYTHREE, ADVISED ONE OF ALLEGATIONS MADE AGAINST HIM WAS OSWALD HAD FERRIE/S LIBRARY CARD IN HIS POSSESSION WHEN ARRESTED AND OSWALD HAD USED FERRIE/S LIBRARY CARD TO OBTAIN BOOKS FROM NEW ORLEANS PUBLIC LIBRARY. FERRIE STATED HIS LIBRARY CARD WAS IN HIS PERSONAL PROPERTY IN CUSTODY OF NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPT. ON NOV. TWENTYFIVE SIXTYTHREE AND HIS LIBRARY CARD EMPIRED MARCH THIRTEEN, SIXTYTHREE. FERRIE SAID HE HAD NOT APPLIED FOR A NEW LIBRARY CARD AND HIS LIBRARY CARD HAD NEVER BEEN OUT OF HIS POSSESSION
