Item 1. PRESIDENTIAL VISIT TO DALLAS, TEXAS, NOVEMBER 22, 1963

FORREST SORRELS, U. S. Secret Service, advised on 11/20/63 that due to previous experiences of Ambassador ADLAI STEVENSON and others with some dissentient groups in the city of Dallas, the bullet-proof-bubble type Lincoln automobile was being flown to Dallas in an Air Force Transport plane and that the President would use same. He stated that he did not anticipate using this automobile either in Ft. Worth or Houston during the President's visits this week in those Texas cities.
