Why does J. Edgar Hoover brand the Revill report as false? Was Mr. Hoover in Dallas on November 22, 1963? If not, how can he state categorically that FBI agent Joe Mosty did NOT have a witnessed conversation with Dallas police Lt. Jack Revill on that day?

The FBI had a DETAILED dossier on Oswald including a report on his rifle purchase in March 1963, and his trip to Mexico in September 1963. The FBI was also aware Oswald held employment in the Texas Schoolbook Depository Building, a half-empty warehouse on the route of the Presidential motorcade.

For these reasons we suggest History will find Mr. Hoover's current behavior reprehensible. The question is not: Did the FBI suffer a tragic error in judgment on November 22, 1963? The question is: Was this error by accident or design?
