RE TEL. CALL, NOV. TWENTYSEVEN, INST. FROM MR. BRANIGAN OF THE BUREAU TO DALLAS REQUESTING INFO. REGARDING ACTIVITY OF THE DALLAS DIVISION WITH RESPECT TO THE INVESTIGATION OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, FROM NOV. ONE, LAST TO NOV. TWENTY-TWO LAST.

THE INFO. HEREINAFTER IS REFLECTED IN GENERAL IN NEW ORLEANS ATEL TO BUREAU AND DALLAS, OCT. TWENTYFIVE, LAST, DALLAS ATEL TO BUREAU AND NEW ORLEANS OCT. THIRTY, LAST, DALLAS ATEL TO BUREAU, NEW ORLEANS AND LITTLE ROCK, DATED NOV. FOUR, LAST, AND DALLAS TEL. TO BUREAU, NOV. TWENTYFIVE, LAST.

BY REFERENCED ATEL OF OCT. TWENTYFIVE, LAST, RECEIVED AT DALLAS, OCT. TWENTYEIGHT, LAST, NEW ORLEANS ADVISED OSWALD HAD LEFT A FORWARDING ADDRESS, WHEN HE LEFT THERE ON TWENTYFIVE ONE FIVE WEST FIFTH ST., IRVING, TEXAS, ON OCTOBER TWENTY-NINE, LAST, SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR. TO WHOM THE CASE IS ASSIGNED, MADE A DISCREET NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTIGATION AND DETERMINED OSWALD'S

WIFE, MARINA OSWALD, HAD BEEN RESIDING AT TWO FIVE ONE FIVE WEST FIFTH, IRVING FOR A SHORT WHILE, BUT OSWALD HIMSELF WAS NOT LIVING THERE <sup>was</sup> ALTHOUGH HE VISITED HIS WIFE AND FAMILY THERE PERIODICALLY. IT WAS ESTABLISHED MRS. OSWALD WAS LIVING WITH A MRS. MICHAEL R. RUTH PAINE, AT THE FOREGOING ADDRESS, MRS. PAINE BEING DESCRIBED AS A RUSSIAN LANGUAGE TEACHER, AT ST. MARKS SCHOOL FOR BOYS, IN DALLAS.

ON OCT. THIRTY-ONE, LAST A CREDIT AND CRIM. CHECK WAS CONDUCTED ON MRS. PAINE AND ENTIRELY FAVORABLE INFO. WAS RECEIVED THERE, AND BY ADDITIONAL INQUIRY THROUGH ST. MARKS SCHOOL IN DALLAS. NO REFERENCES IDENTIFIABLE WITH HER FOUND IN INDICES.

ON NOV. ONE, LAST, MRS. PAINE WAS INTERVIEWED AT TWO FIVE ONE FIVE WEST FIFTY ST., IRVING. SHE CONFIRMED SUBJECT-S WIFE WAS LIVING WITH HER, AND SAID SUBJ. WAS LIVING AND WORKING IN DALLAS, BUT USUALLY VISITED HIS WIFE IN IRVING ON WEEKENDS. MRS. PAINE NAMED SUBJECT-S EMPLOYER AS THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY CO. AT FOUR ONE ONE ELM ST., DALLAS, BUT SAID SHE DID NOT KNOW WHERE HE WAS ROOMING DURING THE WEEK.

MRS. PAINE WAS AGAIN INTERVIEWED ON NOV. FIVE, LAST, BY SA HOSTY AND ANOTHER AGENT. THIS INTERVIEW WAS TERMINATED BEFORE MRS. PAINE COULD BE QUESTIONED TO ANY EXTENT WHEN MRS. OSWALD ENTERED THE ROOM. THE DETAILS OF THIS MATTER SET OUT IN DALLAS RETEL OF NOV. TWENTY-FIVE, LAST.

MRS. OSWALD IS A SOBER SUBJ. AND THE FOREGOING INVESTIGATION WAS CONDUCTED WITH THE THOUGHT IN MIND OF NOT ONLY ATTEMPTING TO ESTABLISH THE LOCATION OF SUBJ. BUT TO LAY A LITTLE GROUND WORK FOR ANTICIPATED EVENTUAL REQUEST FOR SAC AUTHORITY TO INTERVIEW MRS. OSWALD.

MRS. PAINE WAS ENTIRELY FRIENDLY AND COOPERATIVE ON BOTH INTERVIEWS, AND IT WAS FELT AFTER THE LAPSE OF A LITTLE TIME, SHE COULD BE APPROACHED AGAIN AND INTERVIEWED IN DETAIL FOR BACKGROUND AND ACTIVITY INFO. ON BOTH SUBJ. AND WIFE PRIOR TO INTERVIEW OF THE LATTER.

ON NOV. FOUR, LAST AN ATEL WAS SENT TO NEW ORLEANS ADVISING OF THE VERIFICATION OF SUBJECTS PRESENCE IN DALLAS. ON NOV. NINETEEN, LAST NEW ORLEANS FORM FD - TWO TWO EIGHT, TO BUREAU AND DALLAS, RECEIVED AT DALLAS ON NOV. TWENTY-ONE, LAST, TRANSFERRED ORIGIN FROM NEW ORLEANS TO DALLAS.
