GAL LEE HARVEY OSWALD SUBJECT: INTERNAL SECURITY - I On November 25, 1963, the Director instructed that a complete analysis be made of any investigative deficiencies in the Oswald case and also an analysis made concerning any necessary changes in our procedures ro handling cases of this type. Most of my inquiry concerning the Seat of Government and New Orleans facets of this matter is nearly completed. However, a considerable number of aspects of this matter still remain to be resolved with the Dallas Office. These will involve obtaining detailed explanations from a number of Agents and supervisory personnel which will be time-consuming. Inasmuch as the Dallas Office has been working day and night on the report on the assassination and various other aspects of this case, and in order not to interfere with their making the deadlines on these matters, they have not yet been contacted. Unless advised to the contrary, close contact will be maintained with Mr. Belmont in order to determine the earliest possible time when it will be feasible to get these explanations from Dallas.
