SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

Among those items of evidence received from the Dallas Office today was a 6.5 mm Mannlicher - Carcano cartridge case which was recovered from the Texas Public School Book Depository building. This cartridge case is reportedly one of three cartridge cases found with the rifle used in the assassination of the President.

This cartridge case was not previously examined in the Laboratory but was retained by the Dallas Police Department. It has now been identified as having been fired in the 6.5 mm Mannlicher - Carcano rifle, Serial No. C2766, which was recovered from the Texas Public School Book Depository building. All three cartridge cases which were recovered have now been identified with this weapon. No fingerprints were found on the cartridge case received today.

The other items of evidence received from Dallas will be the subject of a separate memorandum.
