SAC Johnson, Chicago, advised that he had received a telephone call from Maurice Martineau, Supervising Agent of the Secret Service in Chicago. Martineau advised that he had received a call from the Secret Service in Dallas to run out the purchase of a gun and sight from Klein's, Chicago on 3/20/63. Martineau advised that if the FBI was handling this investigation he would not do anything about it other than to advise his Dallas office.

Mr. Johnson told him that the FBI was handling the case.
