We have previously identified the order for the murder weapon submitted to Klein's Sporting Goods Company in Chicago as having been written by Oswald. The gun was shipped to "A. Hidell, P. O. Box 2915, Dallas, Texas. We have now identified the application for this P. O. Box as having been prepared by Oswald.

Dallas, by their letter 11/23/63, submitted application for P. O. Box 29 dated 10/9/62. This card bears the printed name "Lee H. Oswald," home address "3519 Fairmore Avenue, Dallas, Texas." and bears the handwritten signature "Lee H. Oswald." We have compared the pertinent printing and writing on this card and definitely identified it with known writing of suspect Lee H. Oswald, previously furnished to us. It should be noted that although Oswald used the name "A. Hidell" in placing the order for the murder weapon, this name does not appear on his application for the P. O. Box to which the gun was shipped.

A teletype is being dispatched to Dallas advising of this identification. This evidence is being retained in the Laboratory.
