

THE PRESIDENT



At 4:20 P. M., SAC Shanklin of the Dallas Office was telephonically contacted concerning items he plans to send to the Bureau this evening. Shanklin advised these items are as follows:

1. Still photograph of Lee Harvey Oswald holding a rifle with a telescopic sight, and wearing a pistol on his belt.

2. A copy of the television film showing Jack Leon Ruby shooting Oswald on 11-24-63.

Shanklin advised the above material will be brought to Washington, D. C., in the personal custody of the Captain of Braniff Airlines, flight number 110. Shanklin did not know the name of the airline captain. The flight will arrive at National Airport at 7:30 P. M., this date.

ACTION:


