ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

11/25/63
MEMPHIS, TENN.
ACCIDENT ON A FEDERAL HIGHWAY

On the afternoon of 11/25/63, you advised me that Eugene had just received information from E. C. Sourwine, in New York City, to the effect that in New York City the Communist Party is planning to distribute leaflets charging the FBI with a cover-up of the assassination of President Kennedy and that the FBI had not properly handled civil rights investigations.

In line with your instructions, I called our New York office and informed them of the information. I told them to immediately determine whether such leaflets are being distributed and, if so, by whom.

At approximately 4:15 p.m., 11/25/63, I was advised that New York agents have been on the alert and in the suburbs that no leaflets of the kind described by Sourwine are being distributed at this time.

I told Macy to keep alert to this situation and to keep you advised promptly of any developments.
