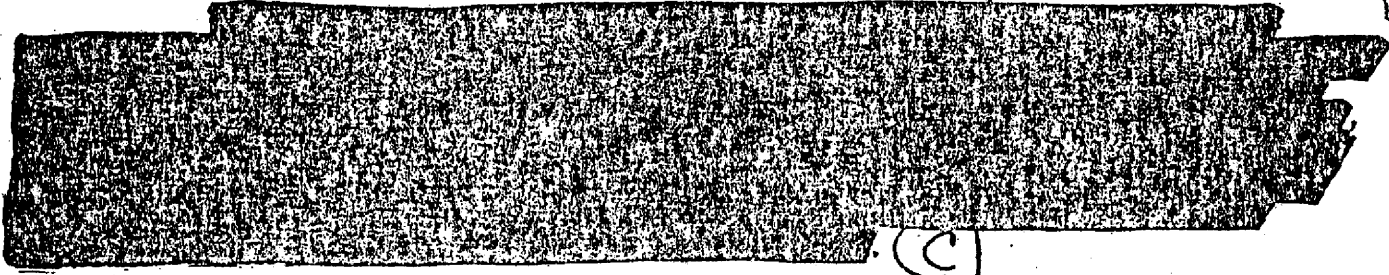

Roney later called back and stated that had New York picked up any correspondence which related to an individual in New Orleans the correspondence would have been forwarded directly to the New Orleans Office and would not have been indexed in the New York Office. (u)

After discussing this matter with you, I called our New Orleans Office and talked with SAC Maynor and ASAC Sylvester. I told them what we were looking for and asked them to check their files. ASAC Maynor stated that the New Orleans Office had already been through its file on Oswald and on the Fair Play for Cuba Committee of which Oswald was a reported member. However, ASAC Maynor stated that in light of this more specific information he would have the files gone through again just to make certain nothing had been overlooked. (u)

ACTION:

I told him he should immediately advise the Bureau in the event any additional material is discovered. He said this would be done.
