The results show Punctate traces of nitrate found in the paraffin on the right and left hands consistent with that of a person who handled or fired a firearm. The paraffin of right check showed no traces of nitrate. This examination was conducted by Dr. M. S. Mason, Director Dallas City County Criminal-Investigative Laboratory.
