ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY , NOV. TWENTYTWO, LAST, DALLAS, TEXAS, AFO. RE BUREAU CALL TODAY.

PAGE ONE TWENTYTHREE, FORST PARAGRAPH, DALLAS REPORT, CONTAINS STATEMENT THAT DISTANCE FROM FRONT DOOR OF THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY TO THE BUS STOP IS SEVEN BLOCKS. BY GOING DIRECTLY FROM THE FRONT DOOR TO THIS BUS STOP, EAST ON ELM STREET, IT IS DIANCE OF FIVE BLOCKS AND TIME REQUIRED TO WALK SAME IS FIVE MINUTES. TO COMVER POSSIBILITY THAT OSWALD ATTEMPTED TO AVOID BEING SEEN ON ELM STREET IMMEDIATELY AFTER SHOOTING, A ROUTE WAS ALSO WALKED AND TIMED FROM FRONT DOOR OF BUILDING ONE BLOCK EAST ON ELM, ONE BLOCK NORTH TO PACIFIC, EAST ON PACIFIC TO LAMAR, SOUTH BACK TO ELM, THEN EAST ON BUS STOP. THIS IS DISTANCE OF SEVEN BLOCKS AND REQUIRED SEVEN MINUTES, A POSSIBLE MAXIMIM TIME OSWALD WOULD HAVE USED TO COVER THIS DISTANCE.
