ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY, NOVEMBER TWENTY TWO, SIXTY THREE.

FOR INFORMATION OF BUREAU, OFFICE OF COORDINATOR OF CUBAN AFFAIRS, MIAMI, INFORMED STATE DEPARTMENT FEELS SOME MISGUIDED ANTI CASTRO ACTION GROUP MIGHT SEIZE ON PRESENT SITUATION AND DEPART ON UNAUTHORIZED RAID AGAINST CUBA, BELIEVING ASSASSINATION MIGHT HERALD CHANGE IN POLICY, WHICH IS CONTRARY TO TRUTH.

ALL SECURITY INFORMANTS AND SOURCES ABERTED AND CONTACTED IN CUBAN FIELD ADVISED GENERAL FEELING IN ANTI CASTRO CUBAN COMMUNITY IS ONE OF STUNNED DISBELIEF, AND EVEN AMONG THOSE WHO DID NOT ENTIRELY AGREE WITH HIS POLICIES CONCERNING CUBA, THE FEELING IS THAT HIS DEATH REPRESENTS GREAT LOSS NOT ONLY TO US BUT ALL LATIN AMERICA. NO UNAUTHORIZED ACTION AGAINST CUBA KNOWN TO BE PLANNED.

[REDACTED] WHO IS CLOSE TO SMALL PRO CASTRO GROUP IN MIAMI, HAS ADVISED THESE PEOPLE ARE AFRAID INCIDENT MAY RESULT IN STRONG REPRESSIVE MEASURES AGAINST THEM, AND P3
