RE: POSSIBLE VIOLENCE TO FAMILY
OF PRESIDENT JOHN KENNEDY

On November 25, 1963, a source who has not been contacted sufficiently to determine his reliability, furnished the following information.

On November 22, 1963, shortly after the assassination of President KENNEDY, one "JIMMY BLUE EYES" remarked in a shoe shine parlor located in the vicinity of 163rd Street, Miami Beach, in the presence of one JIMMY COMER, a shoe shine boy, to the effect, "They should have gotten the whole family. They should have gotten ROBERT".

"JIMMY BLUE EYES" is an alias known to have been used by VINCENT ALO, a self-admitted gambler. ALO's address as of May 1963, was 1248 Monroe Street, Hollywood, Florida. Reportedly he was born as VINCENZO ALO May 26, 1904, New York City.
