Re telephone call from Assistant Director TROTTER
to SAC, Dallas, 11/26/63.

There is being forwarded herewith three negatives
of what was believed to be a fingerprint or palmprint on
the trigger guard assembly of rifle, Serial Number C2766,
believed used by LEE HARVEY OSWALD in the assassination of
President KENNEDY. These photographs were requested by
Assistant Director Trotter for further study. Lt. CARL
DAY of the Dallas PD has requested these negatives be
returned to him at the Dallas PD whenever the Bureau has
completed its examination. Lt. DAY stated he is in no
hurry to get these back and the Bureau should take what-
ever time needed.

There is also being forwarded herewith a finger-
print which was taken by Lt. CARL DAY from the underside
of the gun barrel which is covered by the wooden foregrip
underneath the barrel. The Bureau is requested to examine
the single fingerprint, which appears to be smudged, for
comparison purposes with known fingerprints of LEE HARVEY
OSWALD. Lt. DAY also requested that this latent be returned
to him whenever the Bureau has completed its examination.
