[redacted] On November 26, 1963, [redacted] of  
the [redacted], Mexicali, Baja California, of  
Mexico, advised he had learned unofficially through his  
office that during the late President KENNEDY's visit to  
Mexico in 1962, [redacted] of Mexico City arrested an  
American whom they had received information was planning  
an assassination of KENNEDY in Mexico.

[redacted] said he did not learn the name of the  
alleged American, but expressed a belief this information  
would be made available by the [redacted] Mexico  
City, if it is not already in the possession of the United  
States authorities.
