Q67 was removed from the wallet of OSWALD which was among the items personally delivered to the Laboratory on 11/27/63, by agents of your office.

For your investigative assistance, certain handwriting differences were noted in the Hidell signature on Q67 which indicate that OSWALD, K4 and K5, probably did not prepare this signature.

Q67 White card captioned "FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE
NEW ORLEANS CHAPTER" issued 6/15/63, bearing the
signatures "Lee H. Oswald" and "A. J. Hidell"

Result of examination:

It was concluded that the Oswald signature on Q67
was written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case.

Due to the limited nature of the Hidell signature
and the lack of comparable known handwriting of OSWALD, no
conclusion could be reached whether he did or did not prepare
the Hidell signature on Q67.

The submitted evidence is retained.
