situation. It is alleged GRAHAM was advised by the secretary a reply from the Senator regarding this matter would be received by GRAHAM within two weeks.

At 6:30 p.m. 12/2/63 Mrs. COULTER again called WFO and advised, "They are making a copy and I will call when it is finished."

Mrs. COULTER telephonically recontacted WFO on the evening of 12/2/63 and advised she had contacted one LEW MARTIN at WTOP radio station and was unable to obtain the abovementioned tape. Mrs. COULTER suggested the FBI contact the Columbia Broadcasting Company at 485 Madison Avenue in New York City to obtain this tape.

Mrs. COULTER again telephoned the WFO on the evening of 12/2/63 and suggested WFO locate Rev. BILLY GRAHAM through contact with his home in Montreat, North Carolina, and interview him concerning this matter.

WFO files reflect that Mrs. COULTER contacted WFO in 1942 to report a saboteur school conducted at 1911 M St., N.W., and in 1950 to report that VELMA DE SMITTER was supporting a foreigner with subversive leanings. In addition, the name, "Mrs. COULTER," was reported in 1951 by an anonymous source indicating she had canceled her passport to Czechoslovakia.

In view of Mrs. COULTER's initial contact wherein she stated a friend had the tape recording as opposed to the subsequent communication wherein she stated that she was attempting to obtain the recording from LEW MARTIN at WTOP, and further considering Mrs. COULTER's previous contacts with WFO as reflected above, no additional contacts will be made with Mrs. COULTER and no leads set forth.
