


SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY
NOVEMBER 22, 1963
DALLAS, TEXAS

Inspector Malley called at 2:00 p. m., today from Dallas. He advised that the note written by Oswald to his wife is being forwarded this afternoon together with an English translation from Russian.

The note and an accompanying airtel will be on Braniff Airlines Flight 58 which departed Dallas 12:43 p. m., CST, and will arrive at Dulles Airport 4:06 p. m., EST. Captain W. W. Mitchell is the pilot.

Inspector Malley advised that the airtel will request certain examination on the note including examination for fingerprints and handwriting examination.


Washington Field Office has been advised an Agent will meet the plane and bring the package to Mr. Rosen's office.
