SUBJECT: PROPOSED MARCH OF 40,000 ON GRAVE OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY, DECEMBER 1, 1963

With reference to the information received by the Washington Field Office (WFO) that Drew Pearson had advised the Ambassador Enrique Tejera-Paris of Venezuela that he and others are involved in organizing a mass march of 40,000 Protestants, Jews and Catholics to the President's grave on December 1, 1963, we have advised through liaison the State Department, Secret Service, the military intelligence agencies and the Department. WFO has also advised the Metropolitan Police Department, the National Park Police and other appropriate law enforcement agencies.
