SUBJECT ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY
DALLAS, TEXAS, NOVEMBER 22, 1963

Included among Oswald's effects obtained from the Police Department in Dallas was a brown wallet containing miscellaneous pictures and identifications (fourteen separate items). ASAC Kyle G. Clark has telephonically advised that the Police Department failed to photograph the contents of the wallet before turning it over to our Dallas Office and requested that they be furnished immediately photographs of these items. The photographs which included various Civil Service, Social Security and other identification cards, as well as photographs of Oswald and a woman and baby, presumably his family, and a slip of paper containing the Washington, D. C., address of the Soviet Embassy on one side and "The Worker" in New York City on the other have been forwarded to Dallas.

A document examination is being made of the above referred to slip of paper and the results will be set forth in a Laboratory report.
