SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY

Submitted by separate cover is one .8 mm film, taken 11/22/63, by ABRAHAM ZAPRUDER, Dallas, Texas. The film depicts assassination of President KENNEDY and the wounding of Governor CONNALLY. Bureau Laboratory requested to make three copies of this, maintaining one for Bureau use and returning two to Dallas by most expeditious means possible. The enclosed film should also be returned to Dallas for return to U. S. Secret Service, Dallas, from whom it was obtained this date. Secret Service advises their headquarters, SOG, also have copy of film. Eastman Kodak, Dallas, advises that they developed original negative and three copies for ZAPRUDER.
