D. Tippitt of the Dallas Police Department was killed. Our Los Angeles Office has determined that a . 38 caliber Smith and Wesson revolver with 2" barrel bearing this serial number was shipped to "A. J. Hidell, P. O. Box 2915, Dallas, Texas," by Scaport Traders, Inc., of Los Ángeles on 3/20/63. Los Angeles has submitted the mail order coupon utilized by "A. . Hidell" in ordering the weapon and we have identified the writing thereon as being that of Lee Harvey Oswald.
