Result of examination;

It was concluded that the pertinent handwriting, hand printing, and signatures on Q35 through Q39 were written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5, whose additional known writings are designated above as K24 through Kc26 and K30. ✓

No indented writing was found on page 61 of the June, 1963, issue of the magazine "The American Rifleman" in K27. It is noted that the murder weapon was shipped from Klein's store in Chicago on 3-20-63, and the order blank for the weapon could not have been torn from page 60 of the June, 1963, issue of the magazine in K27. ✓

The submitted evidence is retained. ✓

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
