A. Schmidt that he and another Agent had this date interviewed Washington attorney Edward P. Morgan. Morgan declined to furnish the pertinent information, stating that he could not do so because of attorney-client relationship. Morgan said he could not identify his clients without their authority. Morgan indicated that his clients are responsible individuals who entered a project which they understood had high-level Government approval. Morgan inferred that this project involved a plot to assassinate Fidel Castro, which plot did not materialize. ACTION: Supervisor Tucker will prepare a letterhead memorandum to be forwarded to the Bureau with appropriate cover communication on 3-21-67, setting forth the details of the interview.
