Remy previous memo this date.

Following additional information obtained by writer this date from Mr. ROBERT D. JOHNSON, Chief Counsel, Passport Office, Department of State.

An operations memorandum dated 6/12/62, the American Embassy at Moscow, informed Department of State that steamship tickets had been purchased for subject, his alien wife and infant to be delivered to them in Rotterdam on 6/4/62, for repatriation to United States, cost \$418.00. Communication added that portion of cost of rail tickets for OSWALD family from Moscow to Rotterdam was paid by Embassy, Moscow, in amount of \$17.71. Total amount of expenditure \$435.71. Destination of family said to be New York City.

Noted above information originally comes from files of Office of Special Consular Service, Department of State, which handles welfare and whereabouts of American citizens abroad and handles repatriation to the United States by repatriation loan if destitute.
