LEE HARVEY OSWALD, IS DASH R, OO DALLAS.

AT TEN THIRTY EIGHT A.M. TODAY, LIEUTENANT COLONEL ROBERT JONES,
OFFICE OF AC OF S, G DASH TWO, FOURTH ARMY, TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED
JAMES E. MUSTO, E DASH THREE, FORT CHAFFEE, ARKANSAS, TURNED HIMSELF
IN TO HIS BATTALION COMMANDER AND STATED HE HAD A PART IN ASSASSINATION
OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY, THAT HE WAS IN DALLAS DAY PRESIDENT SHOT AND
KNEW OSWALD. MUSTO WAS AWOL AT THAT TIME.

COL. JONES STATED LITTLE ROCK FBI OFFICE ADVISED AND THAT MUSTO
BEING QUESTIONED BY SA CHARLES GUNTER AT FORT CHAFFEE.
