Just a brief note to thank you for the Supplement to your list of CDs which you kindly enclosed with your note of the 12th, and to send you the enclosed copies of the relevant pages of the Joesten "Truth Letter" (re Masterman/Davison).

Two issues of the Joesten newsletter have come out since I asked him to retract his misleading story to the effect that I had accepted the WR version of the arraignment, but no retraction and no reply to my letter. A good index to Joesten's reliability and manners.

For your information, I have recently come across a bibliographical work, "The Kennedy Literature," which includes a section on the WR and the critics' books, by Professor James Tracy Crown of NWU (published 1968 by NYU Press). And you undoubtedly know already that Jesse Curry has a book coming out in which he has second thoughts about LHO being the lone assassin and admits that there is no evidence that he fired the rifle.
