Through Harold, I understand that you want copies of the testimony of Frazier and Finck in New Orleans. I will send them both as soon as I get them from Nichols (in a few days). Some of my colleagues have asked me to keep my work on this in confidence, but I want you to see it and hope that you could offer suggestions, further information, or speculation on the possible significance. Please keep it in strictest confidence; I am sure you understand why this includes not passing it on to other critics (including my colleagues!) Davison's interest in the Oswalds may be completely innocent, but who knows?
