There certainly has been a lot happening lately. I don't know if you are active at all now, but I thought you might be interested in the enclosed memo on the CIA and the Kennedy case, which I have sent to the various committees investigating the CIA.

I think section IV has some particularly important material (and is particularly sensitive - so please don't spread it around; if you have any ~~new~~ ideas about ~~for~~ forcing someone to ~~ix~~ investigate it, please let me know). You might find the postscript interesting - I was struck by ~~how~~ the similarities between the ~~Coleman~~ Coleman - Slawson speculation and some of your own analysis. I've approached Slawson and he has been pretty good, but he doesn't seem too eager to abandon the Report.

Peter Scott will be covering the assassination in his class the quarter, and he doesn't have his ~~own~~ own copy of your book. Do you know where he could get a copy (or several copies, for the students)?

I see from my files that I didn't acknowledge your letter of 6/14/74. As always, your comments were valuable to me, and I do thank you for them.
