Here are two more lists of clippings and notes on recent developments. (4/14, 4/21) Also, a document on Army Intelligence (89-69-166) which I found quite provocative. (I got this from Harold, and am awaiting his permission to send it around, so I guess you should consider it confidential for a while.)

Jeff says that the HSC is sending a copy of the transcript of the critics' conference to Peter. It's not clear if you will be getting your own copy. If not, are you interested? (It's supposedly about 500 pages.)

Have you heard about Jim Kostman's problems? I guess it amounts to a ~~xxx~~ full-scale freakout. He's in a ~~xxx~~ hospital in Philadelphia now, and reportedly is hostile to the ~~xx~~ psychiatrists. Jerry Policoff has more details, and an unfortunate Washington Post article, if you want more information. Jim's mother reportedly thinks that a note or card c/o them would be appropriate (Mr. & Mrs. Arthur Kostman, 1511 Sheffield Lane, Phila. 19151), but apparently nobody really knows what the situation is.

Jeff assured me that Jim's problems were primarily personal rather than political - insofar as the two can be separated - but certainly being in Washington working on the JFK case is very stressful under the ~~xx~~ best of conditions.
