I am just too overcome by the suggestion that I have a soft spot for the CIA to muster a retort--I think I will just let that go *no*le contendre.

But I do want to thank you most warmly for your generous compliments to Accessories After the Fact and will take this opportunity to ask you, as I have often meant to do, what you make of the section I called "A Strange Arraignment" (pages 305-309). After studying all the available evidence, I was certainly convinced that you were right in charging that Oswald had never been arraigned at all for the murder of President Kennedy.

The enclosed "collage" is not sent to annoy you but only in the hope that your fervent confidence in Garrison will not prevent you from finding some amusement in his volte face. On the other hand, I do agree with you that the stated motivation of Sirhan for shooting RFK is highly implausible and does not rigg true at all.
