As you suggest in your letter of 29 October 1968, I am today mailing you a signed copy of ACCESSORIES AFTER THE FACT together with excerpts from some of the reviews it received. I shall look forward to receiving your new book THE DARK SIDE OF LYNDON B. JOHNSON (does he have a "light" side?).

I look forward also to seeing TRUTH LETTER (No.4) and if it is not inconvenient perhaps you will send me also the first three issues. As you intend to quote from my recent article ("Three Assassinations"), I should like to see that issue too, if you agree. In turn, I will send you any brief item which seems appropriate, as the occasion presents itself.

As for Garrison: I am well aware that many of my fellow-critics of the Warren Report do not agree with my views. You will see from the enclosed copy of a letter explaining my position on Garrison that I supported him wholeheartedly at first and volunteered every possible assistance that I could render to his investigation. I changed my mind for compelling and imperative reasons, some of which are mentioned in the enclosed letter, as did some 10 or 12 critics or students of the Dallas affair who had at first placed complete confidence in Garrison and given him fervant support.
