Joachim Joesten released for the press a statement on July 25, 1966, in which he accused Lyndon B. Johnson of "having usurped presidential power in November 1963 by backing the conspiracy to assassinate his predecessor, President John F. Kennedy."

Joesten is releasing (starting August 1966) the first of a series of seven books (in English) detailing Oswald's role as "a spy for the CIA."

"Later, back home again, Oswald became a stool-pigeon and agent provocateur for the FBI..."
